VENUES If in doubt, look out for yellow finger-post signs and follow the direction

Burmieston Farm PH1 3TL From Perth take the A9 north to junction B8063, (approx 2 miles north of Inveralmond roundabout), exit left towards Battleby and Logiealmond. After 4 miles the road bends sharply left. GR022307. At this point continue straight ahead towards Little Glenshee. After 2 miles turn right to Burmieston Farm. Fuller details available on request. Contact triciawaite@icloud.com or Tel 07808 223960

Blackruthven is off the A85 Perth-Crieff road, at West Huntingtower. Go south; signed Tibbermore & Madderty. A mile along on the LHS is The Bield centre; immediately before that entrance is a farm track signed Blackruthven Farm which you take. Continue up the track, always bearing left, and immediately after you reach the large shed turn sharp left to park on the grass beyond the half-built wall.

Cambo: follow brown signs from the A917 St Andrews – Crail road, a mile south of Kingsbarns KY16 8QD into Cambo estate. After emerging from the woodland, bear left and park as directed.

Castlandhill House, Rosyth: Castlandhill House (KY11 2UZ) is on Ferry Toll Road; from A90, take last turn-off before bridge & follow signs for Rosyth then for 'Rosyth Europark'. Go through white gateposts about 200 yards west from the last roundabout, just before the sharp bend. Member lain Dalzel Job is our host.

Cluny Gardens: A9 north to Ballinluig. Exit for Aberfeldy, A827. At 3.5 miles, take right fork to Pitnacree, Strathtay, Weem. After 5 miles, follow brown sign pointing to the garden to the right. Uphill, follow signs to the parking area by the house. Short walk to where we will be working.

Dungarthill: PH8 0JE Take A984 from Coupar Angus to Dunkeld. 2 miles after Caputh the main road bends left and the private minor road goes straight on – take that minor road. Turn right off the drive uphill. After 200 yards you will see a converted railway carriage to the left, then a wider left turn to a large garage/barn where you can park.

Logiealmond – Marybank Farm: A9 north from Perth. After 2 miles, bear left for B8063 for Logiealmond. Pass Chapelhill and ignore a left turn to Methven. Continue, at 500metres, take the track on right to Marybank Farm and park.

Luncarty Church Centre: PH1 3UX From A9 just north of Perth, turn off for Luncarty and follow the road north/south to mini-roundabout. Turn east into Marshall Way and continue following the long curving road until you reach the restaurant on your left. The Church Centre is just behind the restaurant and there is parking space.

Schiehallion: From Aberfeldy, take the B846. As it climbs, watch out for construction vehicles on the bends! After 8 miles, take the road to the left signposted to Schiehallion. We need to use the overflow car park, the entrance to which is beyond the Braes of Foss car park. Any heavy kit can be dropped off at the Braes of Foss car park before driving to the overflow, from which there is a 10 minute walk back again to the foot of the path up Schiehallion. The sheep fank is a further walk uphill of around 20 minutes.

South Mains Farm From the A90 just south of Forfar turn east on to the A932 signed Arbroath then in a few yards turn right again at Lochlands Restaurant and caravan park. This road bends sharply left. From here South Mains farm is the first on the right. From the North on A90, the road is signed Ladenford and Lour. Then follow directions as above.

Merryhill Training Centre KY11 3DR - From north (M90): Heading south on the M90 take the Junction 1c A921/A985 exit toward Kincardine. At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto A985 heading west. Continue on the A985 through Rosyth crossing 3 roundabouts. Ignore the sign for Limekilns and Charlestown and continue until you see the next sign for Charlestown/ Limekilns. Turn left there then immediately left again (you will see a sign on the wall for our Merryhill Training Centre). Our Merryhill Training Centre is on your left.

From south on M90 proceed north over the Queensferry Crossing. Leave the M90 at Junction 1c and go right under the road to the roundabout. Take the first exit onto A985 towards Kincardine heading west. Continue on the A985 through Rosyth crossing 3 roundabouts. Ignore the 1st sign for Limekilns & Charlestown and continue until you see the next sign for Charlestown/Limekilns. Take that left turn & then immediately turn left again.

From west (Kincardine Bridge): Head northeast over the Kincardine Bridge. Head east along A985 for Rosyth and Forth Road Bridge. After approximately 12 miles, and half a mile after the village of Crombie, turn right at the sign for <u>Charlestown/Limekilns</u>. Turn left then immediately left again (you will see a sign on the wall for our Merryhill Training Centre) and the Training Centre is on your left.
